Mâcon, town of history

Buildings painted burnt sienna, buttermilk and rose – Mâcon has a distinctly Mediterranean feel and looks to the south for inspiration. The town centre is endowed with monuments of diversified and imposing architecture.

The Romanesque art

The Romanesque heritage is one of the main riches of South Burgundy. Around the major Romanesque abbeys of Cluny and Tournus are dozens of buildings that bear witness to a long history.

Guide tour of Cluny Abbey built in 910, the Cluny abbey used to be the most powerful Benedictine abbey of the West in the Middle Ages. Its Abbey Church, formerly 187 metres in length and 30 metres in height below the vault, was the largest church in Christendom until the construction of the St Peter's Basilica in Rome.

Guided tour of the town of Cluny: visit to the monastic town with its Romanesque houses.

Guided tour of the **Saint-Martin Church in Chapaize**: it is the only remnant of an ancient priory founded in the 10th century. Listed building, the church is now one of the oldest Romanesque of Burgundy.



Guided tour of the **village of Brancion**: dominated by the profile of its old feudal castle, the beautiful hilltop village of Brancion is perfect for a stroll with its narrow streets lined with old houses, the keep of the castle and its wonderful panoramic view, the covered market with its wooden roof structure dating from the 14th century, and the Romanesque church home to old frescoes.

The archaeological heritage

Discovery of the Archaeological Heritage in Southern Burgundy.

Guided tour of the **Azé Caves**: landmarked prehistoric site. International classification in palaeontology (from 250,000 to 10,000 years old). The prehistoric cave: the one thousand-bear cave. 200 metres of marked paths. The greatest concentration of bear skeletons visible in an open cave. Lion skeletons, including one extremely rare specimen with its entire skull intact. The underground river: 800 metres of marked paths, fossilized and active galleries. Water recreational area, waterfalls, aquatic cave fauna. The site's archaeological museum: an impressive array of minerals, flint rock, bones, weapons, tools, pottery, coins, and cave fauna. Over 3,000 listed artefacts.

With your guide, **climb the Solutré Rock**: sphinx-like amidst the Mâconnais vineyards, the Roche de Solutré seems to lie in wait for visitors. This unusual geological feature, one

of nature's masterpieces, has become a symbol of southern Burgundy. No need to be a geologist to enjoy the superb views from the top. More than just a rock, it's a "Grand Site de France" for you to explore!

Guided tour of the **Museum of Solutré**: it presents the collections of one of the richest prehistoric deposits in Europe: a hunting site frequented for more than 50 000 years by men of the Upper Palaeolithic who came to hunt, to carve and to smoke thousands of horses and Rennes. The archaeological and Botanical Park of Solutré completes the visit of the museum. It allows to discover a wide variety of plant species characteristic of the natural environment and the essential results of archaeological research.

In the footsteps of Lamartine

Tour dedicated to Lamartine, famous poet, writer and politician

Your guide will lead you in Lamartine's footsteps, starting with the **city of Mâcon** where he spent his childhood years.

Visit of Lamartine's family house: built in 1705 by Alphonse de Lamartine's great-grandfather, initially to serve as a «grape-picking room» on the wine estate, it was in this house that the poet spent his entire childhood and adolescence. This family home, to which he was very attached, inspired some of his most beautiful poems. It is now an ISMH listed building. An area of books and documents evoking Lamartine's childhood, his sources of literary inspiration and winegrowing.

Lunch



The Château de Saint-Point (12th century) became the property of the Lamartine family in 1801 and was given to Alphonse de

Lamartine for his marriage in 1820. The poet remodelled it in the romantic Gothic style. It is furnished with Lamartine's memories: the poet's bedroom, his study, and the dining room. The family tomb adjoins the property, opposite the church.

Stop at **Château de Monceau**: this 17th-century château belonged to the de Lamartine family, who spent several months here during the autumn grape harvest.

Stop at **"La Solitude de Lamartine" or "Pavillon des Girondins"**, a place of meditation and writing for Lamartine, poet and statesman. It was in this small octagonal wooden pavilion in the middle of the vineyards of his Château de Monceau that he wrote part of «L'histoire des Girondins» in verse and prose.

The treasures of South Burgundy

In quest of the wonders of South Burgundy

Guided tour of **Berzé Le Châtel castle**: discover the shooting site of Ridley Scott's film «the Last Duel». The feudal castle of Berzé-le-Châtel long remained impregnable. Its various terraces still demonstrate the extent of its defensive system. This ancient fortress of southern Burgundy is mentioned as early as the year 991. Lovely, terraced gardens with a colourful vegetable patch.

Tasting of wines produced by the owners of the castle.

Lunch



Guided tour of the **Monks' Chapel in Berzé-La-Ville**, dating from the 11th century. In 1893 the chapel was classified as a Historic Monument. The chapel is celebrated for its paintings, considered to be the most beautiful

example of Cluniac Romanesque art, and which are very probably the work of artists brought together by Saint Hugues during his journeys to Mont-Cassin. The connection with the Byzantine art of Cappadocia is clear, as is the connection with paintings in Roman sanctuaries of the same period. The paintings here enable us to imagine the decoration, now long gone, used in the Cluny III abbey church.

Guided tour of the **gypsum carries in Berzé-la-Ville**: the gypsum quarries were exploited in Berzé la Ville until the end of the 19th century. Remnants are still visible, such as grinding wheels, nine plaster kilns, and the plaster where a steam mill was, and a shop, administrative buildings, and workers' quarters.

Tournus city of art and history

Come and discover the little gems of Tournus. Follow your guide and let yourself travel through time...

Guided tour of **Tournus**: created by the Romans and was known for the sanctuary dedicated to Saint-Valérien during the 6th century. It was not until the 9th century, when monks from Noirmoutier (fleeing the Vikings) came to Tournus with the relics of Saint Philibert, Tournus became an important religious town. Between the 11th and 13th century, these monks built the superb Abbey.

Guided tour of **Saint-Philibert Abbey**: a masterpiece of Romanesque art from the 11th and 12th centuries. The abbey church, the cloister, the chapter house, the refectory and the cellar constitute the only monastic complex of the 12th century preserved in Europe. The unique architecture of the nave offers a striking light. The crypt and the upper chapel are also worth seeing.

Visit of the Tournus "**Hôtel-Dieu**": historic hospital, built between the 17th and 19th centuries and classified a historical landmark, has preserved all its former rooms (three patient wards and two chapels), presented with their original furnishings: enclosed wood beds, dishes, silver, and pottery. It also houses a well-endowed apothecary, complete with Nevers and Dijon-style ceramics and hand-blown flasks. A wing of the Hôtel Dieu building houses the Greuze Museum.

"Vignerons de Mancey" cellar in Tournus: you will explore this unique museographic tour of the Burgundy region, its vines, and its **wine. Commented tasting** of 3 wines of the Mâconnais area.

The “Bresse” region heritage

Between nature, gastronomy and architecture, the Bresse region is a territory to be discovered

Audio-guided tour of the **Royal Monastery of Brou**: religious complex composed of monastic buildings and a church, which were built at the beginning of the 16th century by Margaret of Austria, daughter of the Holy Roman Emperor Maximilian I and Governor of the Habsburg Netherlands. The complex was designed as a dynastic burial place in the tradition of the Burgundian Champmol and Cîteaux Abbey. The church was built between 1506 and 1532 in a lavishly elaborate Flamboyant Gothic style, with some classicizing Renaissance aspects. The tall roof is covered in coloured, glazed tiles.

Visit of “**Domaine des Saveurs-Les Planons**” in **St-Cyr-Sur-Menthon**: the contemporary setting of the museum showcases the Bresse way of life and traditional dress, as well as the Michelin-starred gastronomy such as the famous “Bresse chicken”.

Located on an area of 48 hectares, the “**Planons Farm**” is the highlight of the visit. **Classified as historical monument**, it is a remarkable example of the architecture of the Bresse region with arcaded galleries and Saracen chimney. Take a step back in 1784 while visiting the authentically reconstructed farm’s interior.

Destination Beaujolais

Meeting with the Saints of South Burgundy Day 1

Guided tour of the **Basilica Notre Dame of Fourvière**: dedicated to the Virgin Mary who is said to have saved Lyon from the Black Death that swept through Europe in 1643. Every year on the 8th December, Lyon thanks the Virgin by lighting candles throughout the city and illuminating walls and buildings in a LED extravaganza. It's called "Fête des Lumières" or the Festival of Lights, which, has become a must-see international event.
